

REQUIREMENTS FOR A MARRIAGE LICENSE courtesy of EdgewaterOnline.com

1. Bride must be a resident of Edgewater, and both the bride and groom must be at least **18** years of age.
2. Bride must show **proof of being an Edgewater resident**, i.e. Driver's License, a bill (showing bride's name and Edgewater address), or a notarized letter from the landlord.
3. Bride and groom must show **proof of birth:** i.e. Birth Certificates, or Passport.
4. **Photo ID with address** for both bride and groom
5. Social Security Number (if applicable).
6. When applying, you must have **one (1) witness** with you.

Witness must:

- be at least 18 years of age
- know both the bride and groom
- may be a family member
- be able to speak and understand English

7. After you apply, there is a **72-hour waiting period** before the license can be issued to you.
8. Must provide name, address, and phone number of the Officiant (Priest, Mayor, Judge, etc.)
9. If divorced, must bring "Final Divorce Decree" papers, showing the Docket number and Judge's signature.
10. If widowed, must bring certified copy of former spouse's death certificate.
11. Marriage License Applications are taken Monday through Friday, between **9 AM and 4:30 PM. by appointment only.**
12. Marriage License fee is **\$28.00** and is payable at time of application.
