would like to remind residents of the following "quality of life" Borough Ordinances - which we must all practice to ensure our town will continue to be a place we can be proud of.

1. Please read the recycling calendar and place your recyclables at the curb on the proper days, and not later **than 7:00 AM**. If the recyclables are not picked up for some reasons, leave at curb and it will be picked up the following day.

2. Place your trash at the curb **after 8:00 PM** on the night of the day scheduled for pickup. That is, for example, put it out on Sunday night after 8:00 PM, Tuesday night after 8:00 PM, or Thursday night after 8:00 PM.

If you're doing major renovations or repairs to your home, you must first obtain a permit from the Building Department — and then you must make arrangements to remove debris that results from the renovations.

3. Furniture or other debris must never be placed at the curb on Friday or Saturday. Put such items out only after 8:00 PM on Sundays. If you have to dispose of a refrigerator, washing machine, dryer, oven, TV, computers, monitors, laptop, keyboards, printer, VCR, mouse, DVD, air conditioners make a call to the Recycling Department at 201-943-1700 ext. 5005. They'll make arrangements with you to pick up the appliance during regular working hours. Don't forget to remove refrigerator and oven doors so children aren't tempted to climb inside! **REMEMBER, IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PROPERTY OWNER TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH THESE REGULATIONS.**

4. Repair or replace sidewalk areas in front of your property that are broken or cracked. It's also the responsibility of homeowners to keep these areas **swept and in good condition**. But if there is a sidewalk or curb that needs work because of a tree, call the Borough Clerk's office to report it. The Borough will be notifying Property Owners of side walks that need to be replaced.

5. Keep your property free of weeds. If there are any in your yard or along your side walk, **please cut them down**. Property with overgrown weeds is not only unsightly; it is a health hazard.

If you're going to cut down tree branches, make sure the resulting pieces are no longer than four (4) feet, and tie into small bundles; then put them at the curb for pickup.

6. When leaves fall from the trees, **rake and leave at curb**. Leaves will be picked up, Mondays through Fridays, from the first of October until the Fifteenth of December. **Please no paper or plastic bags.**

7. **A final reminder:** discarded batteries are a potential menace to our environment. Take them to the Radio Shack in Edgewater Commons; they'll dispose them for you.

We seek earnestly your cooperation in these matters. It's best if your activities are voluntary. If ordinances are ignored and disregarded, however, warning and summonses **will be issued**.

8. The waste removal company will take away a reasonable amount of furniture or other debris. However, it is the responsibility of the resident to make arrangements to have removed large amounts of furniture and debris.
